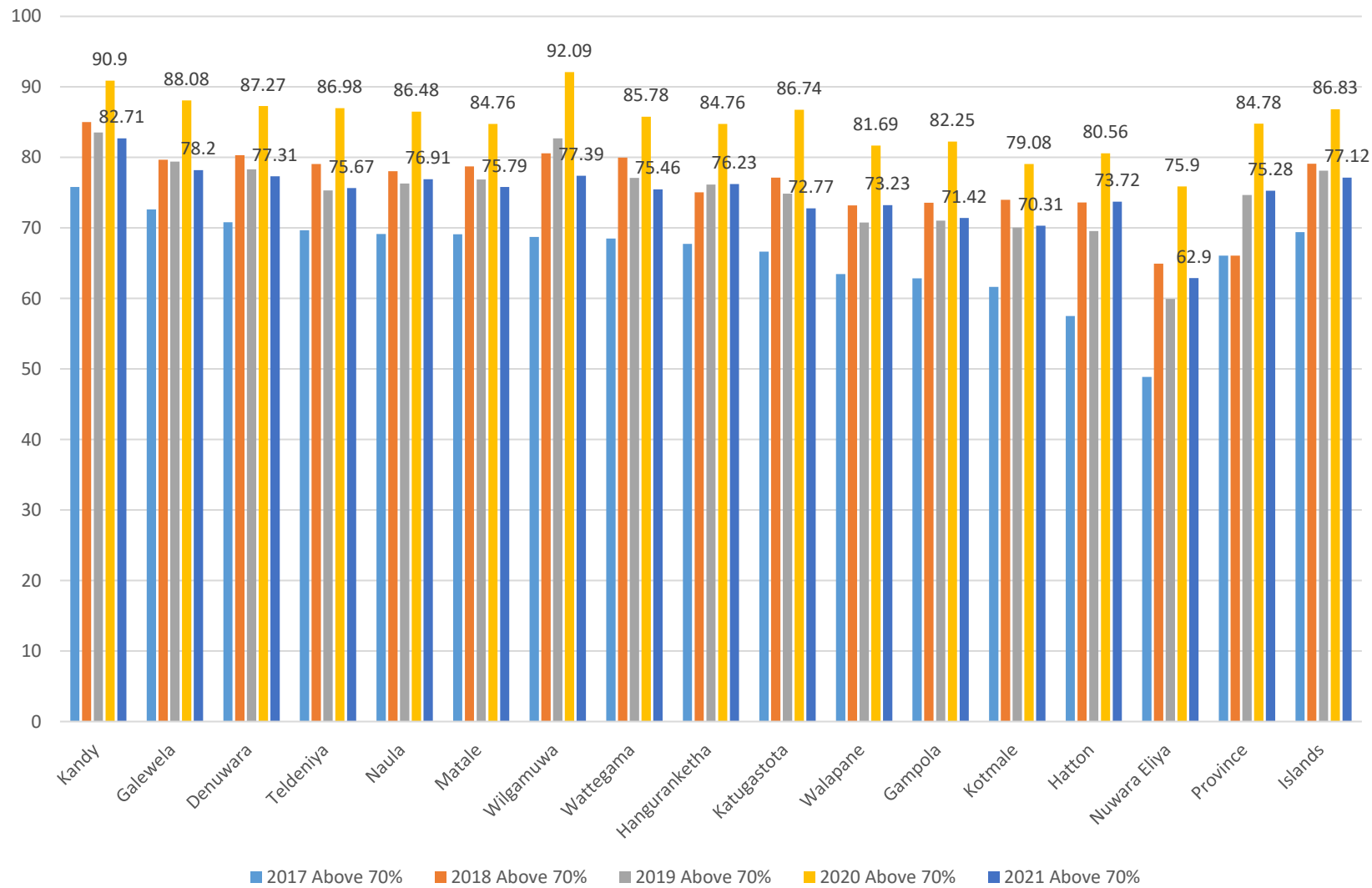

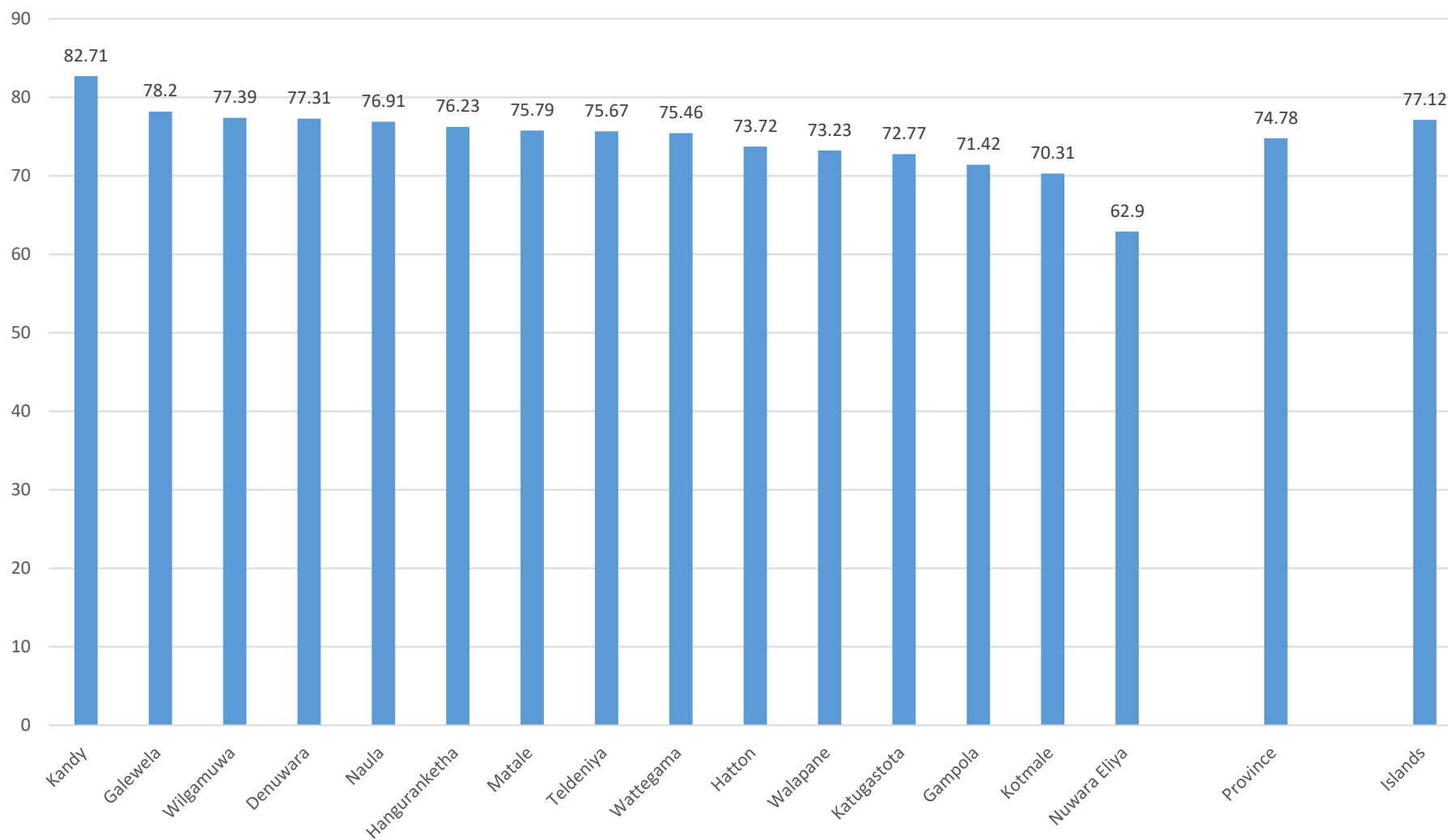

Percentage of obtaining 70 marks or above at Grade 5 scholarship Examination by zone 2021



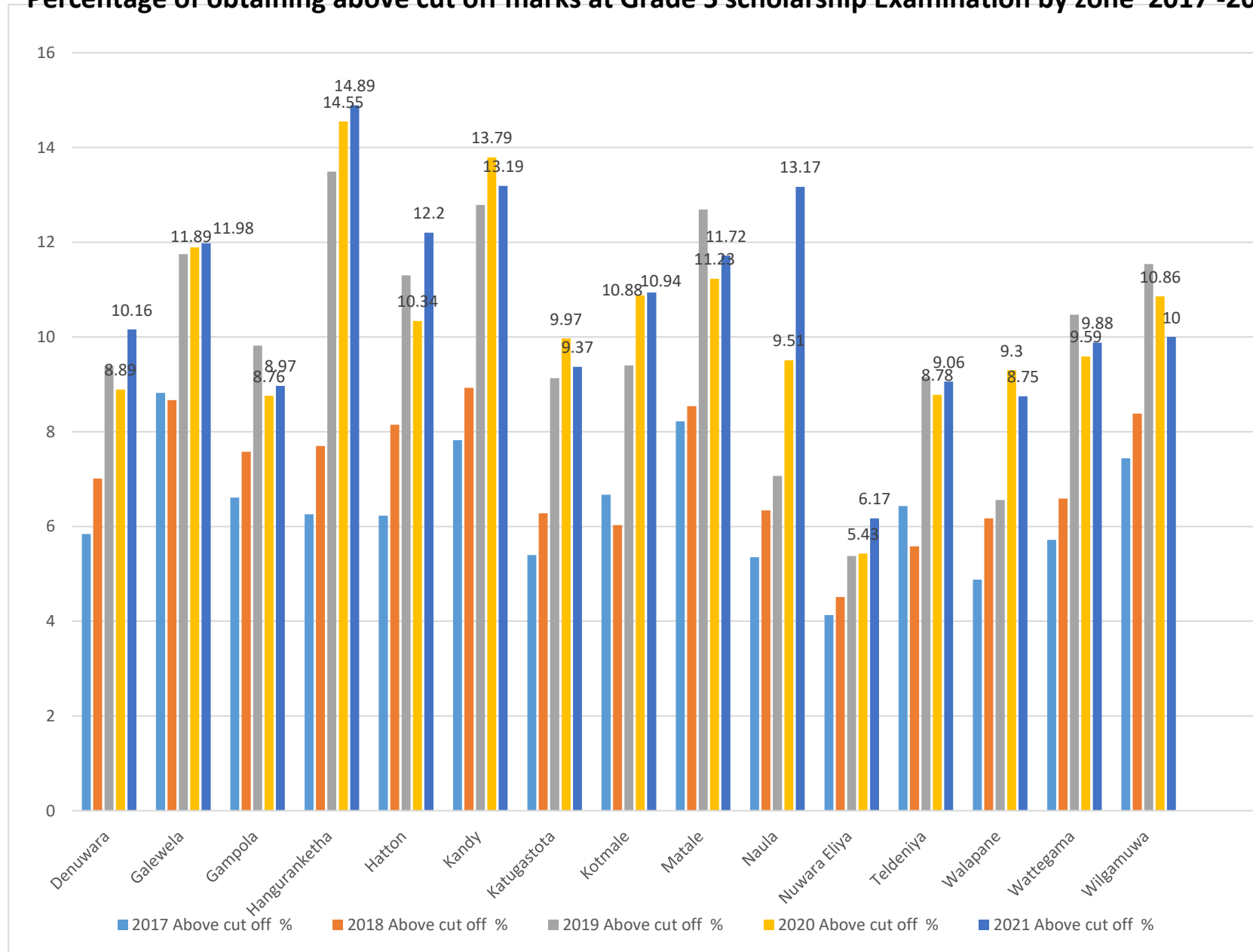

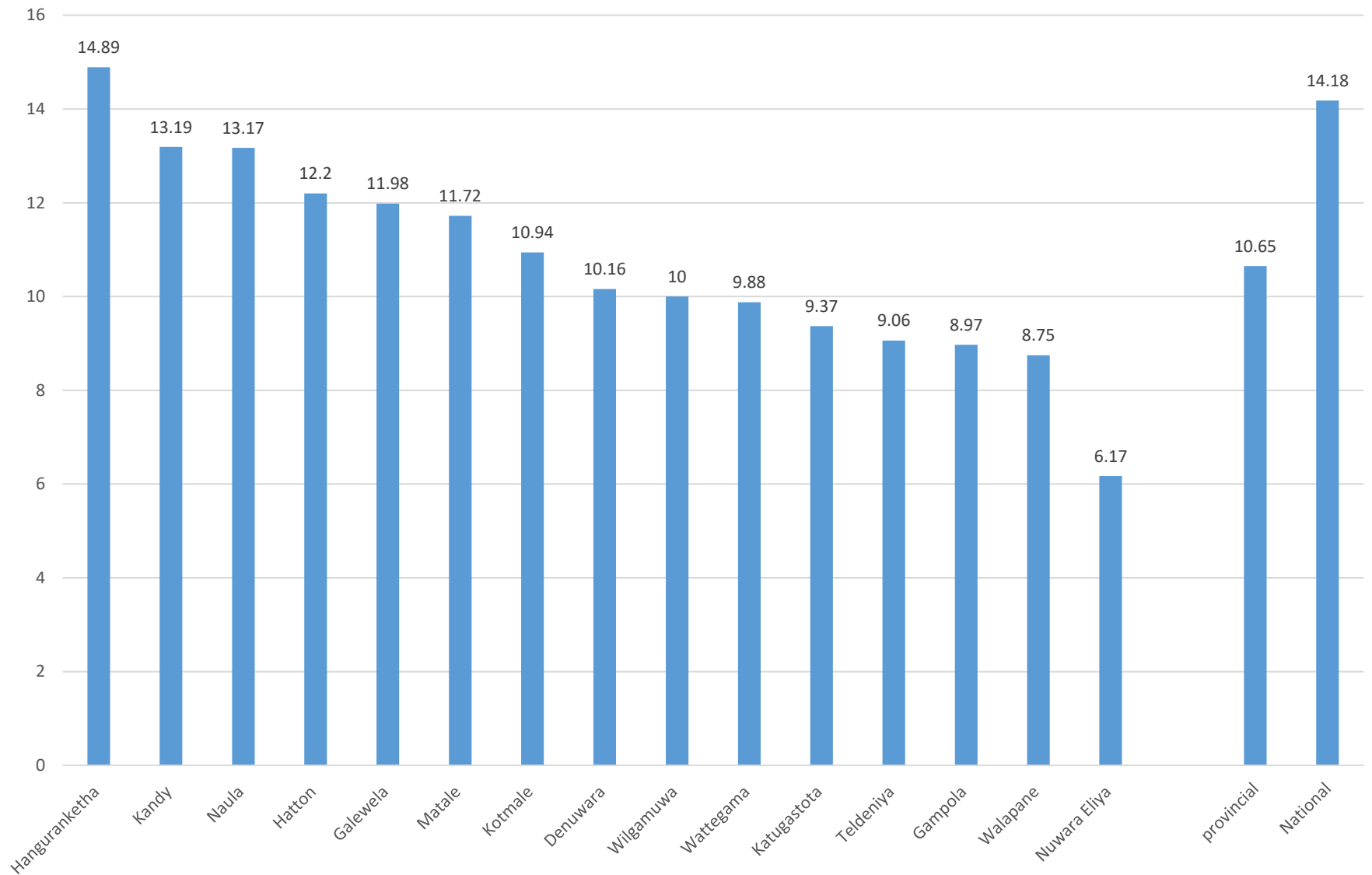

**The programmes that have been carried out at the provincial level in the past years
to raise the student achievement level in the primary sector.**

1. Conducted diagnosis tests for grades 3, 4, 5 and directed the identified students to implement the remedial programmes.
2. Educating teachers through Zonal Officers and ISAs on implementation of Formative Assessment
3. Conducting Mathematics Camps related to Activity Based Mathematics Programme.
4. Implementation of teacher training programmes on implementation of teaching and learning process related to activity room.
5. During the 2020 and 2021 school closures, print and hand out Home Based Assignments to students in grades 1 to 5.
6. Print self-study activity manuals and provide them to students
7. Prepare and provide revision exercises for study units related to main subjects.
8. Broadcasting of recorded lessons via ITV.lk YouTube channel.
9. Providing video stories prepared by Room to Read to students through WhatsApp.
10. Conducting provincial level scholarship practice tests.

Programs to be implemented to improve scholarship exam results in the year -2022

1. Prepare monthly subject assignment sets and give them to students.
 - Language
 - Mathematics
 - Environment Related Activities
2. Prepare potential exercise sets related to the first question paper of the scholarship test and give them to students.
3. Prepare revision exercises for lesson units and give them at the provincial level
4. Prepare and provide equipment sets to diagnose the achievement level of students in those grades.
5. Introduce the remedial program for low achievement students at the provincial level and prepare instructional manuals and implement them through the teachers.
6. Conduct provincial level scholarship rehearsal tests.
7. Directing special interventions for selected schools at the zonal and division level.
8. Identifying the level of students through subject-based online rehearsal exercises for the first and second papers related to the scholarship examination and directing the needy students to carry out remedial programs.
9. Giving targets on the level of marks to be taken at the Grade 5 scholarship examination
